Newly-Improved Streets

(No permit if paved or improved street
surface less than 5 years old unless
Applicant demonstrates public health
or safety require work be permitted or
an emergency condition exists).
Certificate of insurance required.
(Borough's expenses, including but not
limited to engineer's time, inspections, &
other expenses as established on permit
schedule shall be added to permit
fee.)

(Permit Required Under Borough

**B. FEES FOR OBTAINING A MUNICIPAL PERMIT TO ENGAGE IN A
REGULATED ACTIVITY WITHIN THE BOROUGH**

(PERMITS REQUIRED BY OTHER BOROUGH ORDINANCES)

1. Building Permits (Residential - 1 & 2 Family)	Cost (Labor & Material) \$0-\$1,000 = \$50 \$1,001-\$2,000 = \$60 \$2,001-\$4,000 = \$70 \$4,001-\$6,000 = \$80 \$6,001-\$8,000 = \$90 \$8,001-\$10,000 = \$100 \$10,001-\$12,000 = \$110 \$12,001-\$14,000 = \$120 \$14,001-\$16,000 = 130 \$16,001-\$18,000 = \$140 \$18,001-\$20,000 = \$150 \$20,001-\$25,000 = \$200 \$25,001-\$30,000 = \$250 \$30,001-\$35,000 = \$300 and so on charging an additional \$50 for every \$5,000 increment \$4.50 OR THE THEN APPLICABLE STATE FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF A BUILDING PERMIT WILL BE ADDED TO THE COST OF EACH PERMIT

Building Permits (Multi-Family/Commercial/ Industrial/Demolition)	Cost (Labor & Material) \$0-\$1,000 = \$100 \$1,001-\$2,000 = \$110 \$2,001-\$4,000 = \$130 \$4,001-\$6,000 = \$150 \$6,001-\$8,000 = \$170 \$8,001-\$10,000 = \$190 \$10,001-\$12,000 = \$210 \$12,001-\$14,000 = \$230 \$14,001-\$16,000 = \$250 \$16,001-\$18,000 = \$270 \$18,001-\$20,000 = \$290 \$20,001-\$25,000 = \$340 \$25,001-\$30,000 = \$390 \$30,001-\$35,000 = \$440 and so on charging an additional \$60 for every \$5,000 increment
